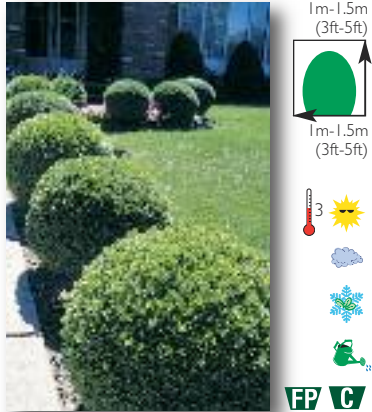

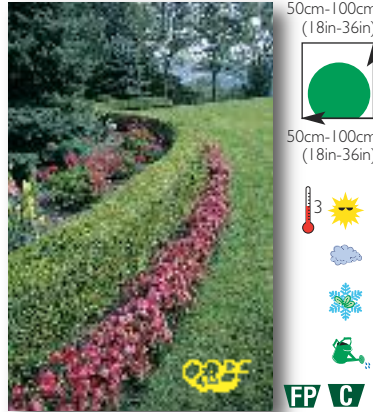
Buxus, Cotoneaster & Euonymus Broadleaf Evergreens

Buxus x 'Green Mountain'
Green Mountain Boxwood



A more upright selection that lends itself well to growing into pyramids. Can be shaped and sheared as an accent plant.

Buxus x 'Green Velvet'
Green Velvet Boxwood



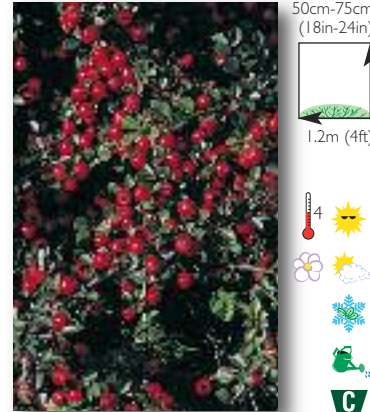
Round full-bodied boxwood well suited for low hedges. Vigorous habit and good green colour throughout winter.

Cotoneaster acutifolius
Peking Cotoneaster



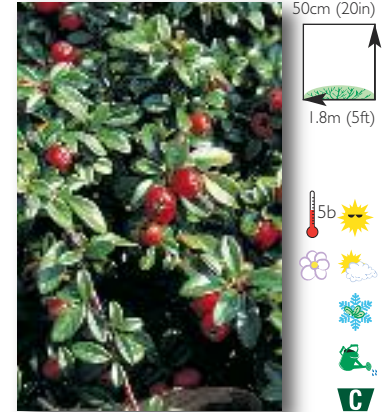
Beautiful dark shiny foliage on this erect, slightly spreading plant. Very hardy, splendid hedge plant. Excellent red-orange fall colour.

Cotoneaster apiculatus
Cranberry Cotoneaster



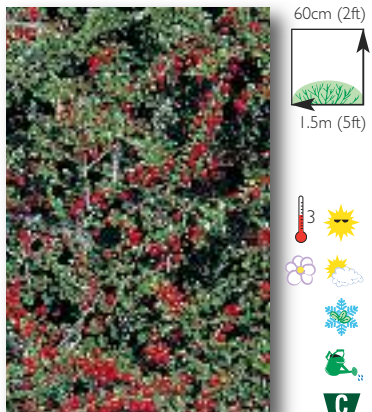
A graceful spreading plant with small pink blooms in spring and cranberry-size, long lasting, bright red berries in the fall. Tolerates drought.

Cotoneaster dammeri 'Coral Beauty'
Coral Beauty Cotoneaster



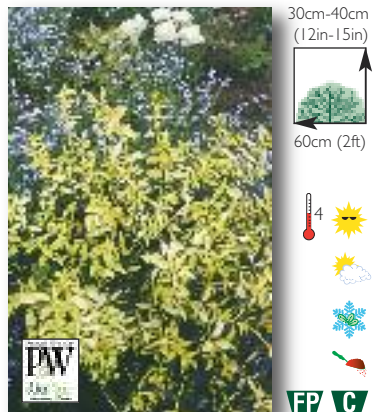
A superb selection as a groundcover or for holding banks. Plant has vibrant green foliage, white flowers, and orange-red fruit. Drought tolerant.

Cotoneaster x 'Hessei'
Hesse Cotoneaster



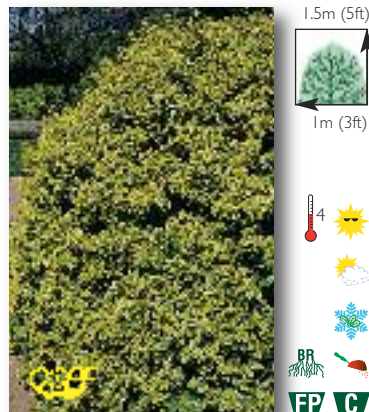
Deciduous horizontally-branched mounding shrub. Lustrous green leaves turn to rich burgundy in fall. Pinkish-red flowers and large red berries. Very hardy. Excellent as a border or groundcover.

Euonymus fortunei 'Interbolwiji'
Blondy Euonymus



A truly outstanding dwarf evergreen shrub. Features dark green foliage with a large yellow centre. An exciting accent or low hedge.

Euonymus fortunei 'Canadale Gold'
Canadale Gold Euonymus



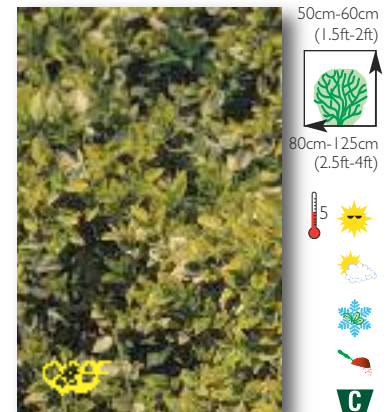
Evergreen shrub has green and gold variegated leaves. Excellent accent plant. Fast growing.

Euonymus fortunei 'Emerald Gaiety'
Emerald Gaiety Euonymus



Small evergreen shrub of dense habit with distinctive white-margined green leaves. Fine accent plant. Can also be used as a climber.

Euonymus fortunei 'Emerald 'n Gold'
Emerald 'n Gold Euonymus



This broadleaf evergreen makes a fine groundcover with a broad upright spreading habit. Foliage is dark glossy green with vivid distinctive yellow margins.

Euonymus fortunei 'E.T. Gold'
E.T. Gold Euonymus



This evergreen shrub has green and yellow variegated leaves and makes an excellent accent plant.

Sarcocoe Euonymus



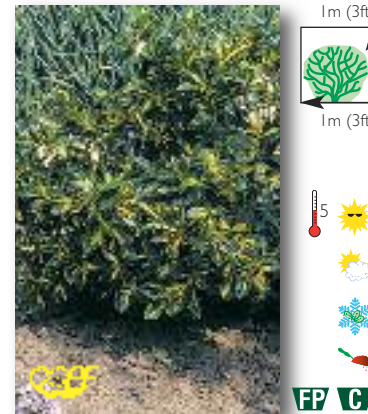
Evergreen of excellent growth. Dark green foliage and small white flowers. Withstands considerable shade.

Sheridan Gold Euonymus



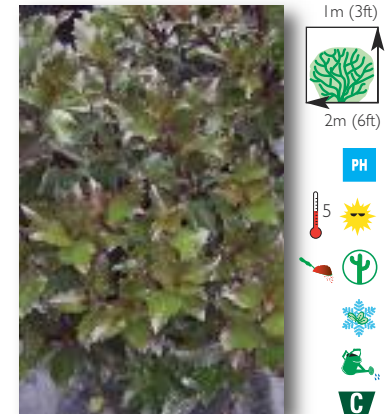
New growth is bright yellow in May, turning a bright green in July.

Large glossy leaves are predominantly rich green with vivid yellow centres. A distinctive addition to any landscape.

Ilex meserveae 'Blue Baron'
Blue Baron Holly



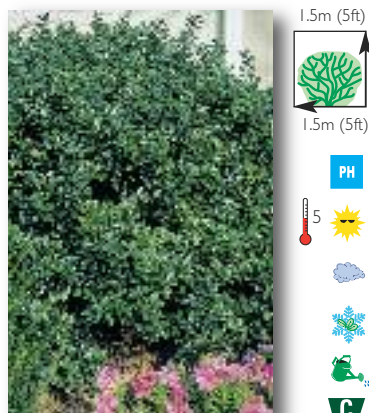
Dwarf male blue holly with attractive low growing habit and a striking wine-red fall/winter coloration. Good pollinator for Ilex 'Blue Angel' and other blue hollies.

Ilex meserveae 'Blue Maid'
Blue Maid Holly



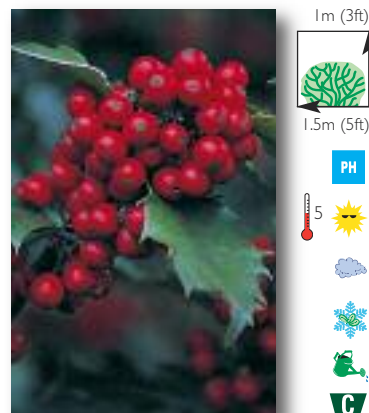
Glossy bluish-green foliage. Needs male holly nearby in order to produce bright red fruit. Perhaps the most hardy of the blue hollies.

Ilex meserveae 'Blue Prince'
Blue Prince Holly



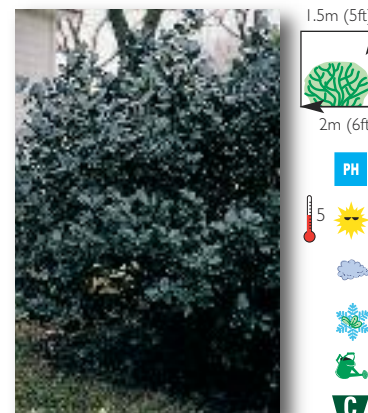
Hardy evergreen shrub. Lustrous dark bluish-green foliage. Needed as a pollinator to female blue holly.

Ilex meserveae 'Blue Princess'
Blue Princess Holly



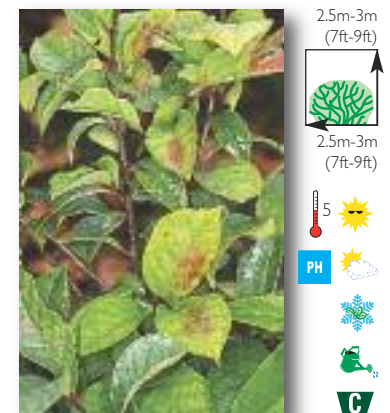
Hardy evergreen shrub. Abundant dark red fruit and lustrous dark bluish-green foliage. Female needs male nearby to bear fruit.

Ilex meserveae 'Blue Stallion'
Blue Stallion Holly



A dense, vigorous grower. Rich glossy leaves are bright bluish-green in colour. Snag-free foliage makes it ideal for walks and borders. Female holly needs male plant nearby to bear fruit.

Ilex verticillata 'Southern Gentleman'
S.G. Winterberry Holly

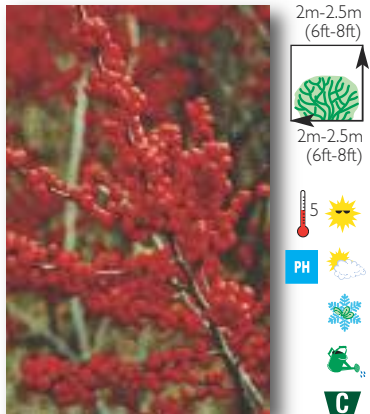


Southern Gentleman blooms relatively late in spring making it the perfect match to pollinate 'Winter Red' and other late blooming Hollies.

Broadleaf Evergreens Ilex & Yucca

Campsis, Lonicera & Wisteria **Vines**

Ilex verticillata 'Winter Red'
Winter Red Winterberry Holly



Winter Red is a female clone which needs a male pollinator to produce the attractive red berries which are the signature of the winterberries.

Adam's Needle Yucca



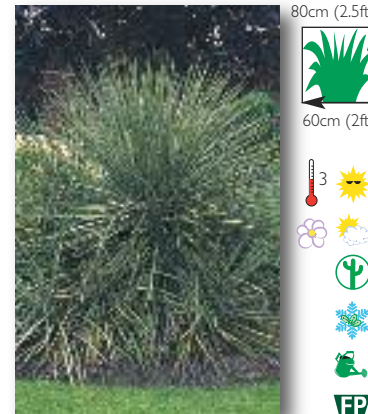
Clump of sword-like evergreen leaves produces a spike of pendulous blooms on a tall slender stem in mid-summer.

Golden Sword Yucca



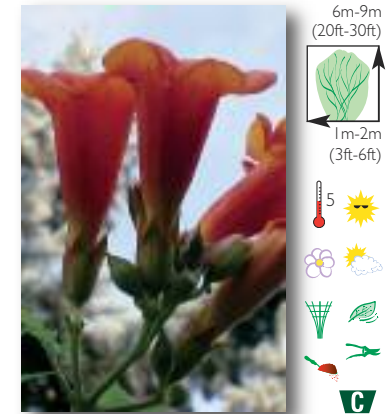
Sword-shaped rich yellow leaves edged in soft green. Tall spikes with white flowers appear in summer.

Spanish Bayonet



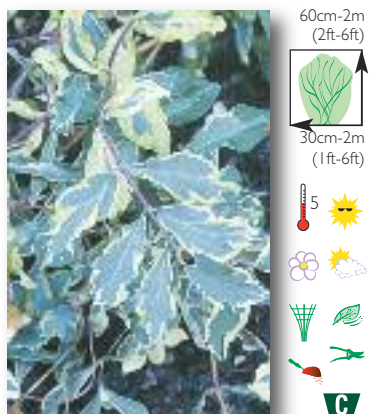
Evergreen shrub with narrow, aqua-green spiked leaves. Creamy-white flowers bloom in the summer.

Campsis radicans
Trumpet Vine



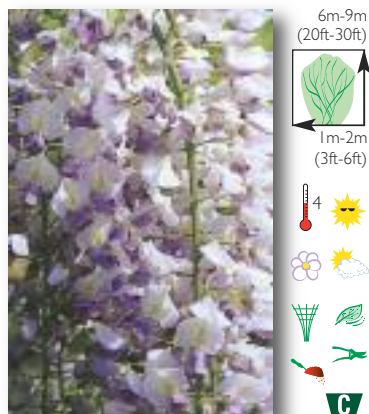
A vigorous, twining vine with shrubby, coarse foliage. Will climb on stone or woodwork. Showy orange-scarlet flowers in mid-summer.

Lonicera periclymenum 'Harlequin'
Harlequin Honeysuckle



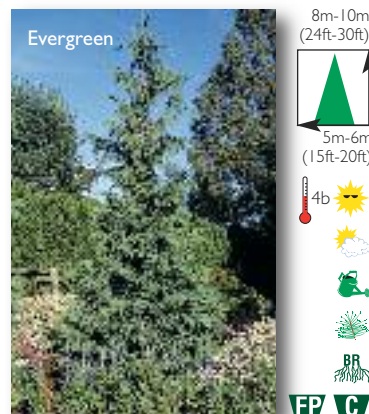
Lovely yellow and pink flowers, fragrant especially at night, adorn this lovely vine. Beautiful variegated foliage, cream edged with pink highlights. Can be pruned to a shrub or trained to grow up a wall or trellis.

Wisteria macrostachya 'Domino'
Blue Moon Wisteria



Smaller form, deciduous vine with green, compound leaves and long, drooping racemes of free-flowering, lilac-blue flowers from late spring until early summer. Hardy to -40°C.

Chamaecyparis nootkatensis 'glauca'
Blue Nootka False Cypress



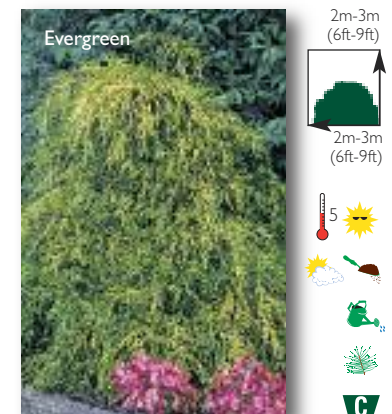
A large evergreen with a pyramidal habit. Branches are horizontal with bluish foliage.

Chamaecyparis nootkatensis 'pendula'
Weeping Nootka False Cypress



Interesting evergreen tree with horizontal branching and weeping foliage. Grows to 10 feet in 10 years. Mature size 30 feet.

Chamaecyparis pisifera 'Filifera Aurea'
Golden Threadleaf Cypress



Striking evergreen. Drooping branches of very fine textured yellow foliage. Lovely accent plant.
